

Official communiqué of the 6992nd (closed) meeting of the **Security Council**

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 27 June 2013, at 3 p.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 6992nd meeting, held in private on 27 June 2013, the Security Council considered the item entitled 'Implementation of the note by the President of the Security Council (S/2010/507)'.

"The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Armenia, Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Costa Rica, Croatia, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Ethiopia, Finland, Gabon, Germany, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Ireland, Israel, Japan, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Malaysia, Mauritania, Mexico, Monaco, Mongolia, Mozambique, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Portugal, the Republic of Moldova, Romania, Senegal, Serbia, Sierra Leone, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Switzerland, the Syrian Arab Republic, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Thailand, Turkey, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Uruguay, Viet Nam, Zimbabwe and Yemen to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to the representatives of the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations and the African Union to the United Nations.

"In accordance with the provisional rules of procedure and the previous practice in this regard, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation to the representative of the Observer State of the Holy See to the United Nations, to participate in this meeting.

"The members of the Council had an exchange of views."
