Official communiqué of the 7189th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
29 May 2014, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 7189th meeting, held in private on 29 May 2014, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘Implementation of the note by the President of the Security Council (S/2010/507).’

“The President invited the representatives of Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Colombia, Cuba, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Hungary, Indonesia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Ireland, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Morocco, Myanmar, Namibia, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Pakistan, Peru, the Philippines, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Switzerland, the Syrian Arab Republic, Tajikistan, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Togo, Turkey, Turkmenistan and Ukraine to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The President invited the representative of the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“In accordance with the provisional rules of procedure and the previous practice in this regard, the President invited the representative of the Observer State of the Holy See to the United Nations to participate in this meeting.

“The members of the Council had an exchange of views.”
