Official communiqué of the 7195th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Monday,
9 June 2014, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 9 June 2014, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 7195th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Operation in Côte d’Ivoire.

“The President invited Ms. Aïchatou Mindouadou, Special Representative and Head of the United Nations Operation in Côte d’Ivoire, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Ms. Mindouadou, via video-teleconference from Abidjan.

“Members of the Council, Ms. Mindouadou and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
