**Official communiqué of the 7569th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday,  
2 December 2015, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 2 December 2015, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 7569th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

“The President invited Mr. Hervé Ladsous, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations and Ms. Ellen Margrethe Løj, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in South Sudan, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Mr. Ladsous and Ms. Løj.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Ladsous, Ms. Løj and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
