Official communiqué of the 8197th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
6 March 2018, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 6 March 2018, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution [1353 \(2001\)](#), held its 8197th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

“The President invited Mr. Jean-Pierre Lacroix, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Mr. Lacroix.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Lacroix and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
