Official communiqué of the 8279th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday,
6 June 2018, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 6 June 2018, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution [1353 \(2001\)](#), held its 8279th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur.

“The President invited Mr. Jean-Pierre Lacroix, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Mr. Lacroix.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Lacroix and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
