The situation in Libya

The President (*spoke in Russian*): In accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I invite the representative of Libya to participate in this meeting.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2018/542, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The President (*spoke in Russian*): The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2420 (2018).
