### Official communiqué of the 8959th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday, 28 January 2022, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 8959th meeting, held in private on 28 January 2022, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Myanmar’.

“The President invited the representative of Cambodia to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The President invited Ms. Noeleen Heyzer, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for Myanmar; and Mr. Ramesh Rajasingham, Assistant Secretary-General for Humanitarian Affairs and Deputy Emergency Relief Coordinator, ad interim, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Council heard briefings by His Excellency Mr. Prak Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Cambodia, in his capacity as Special Envoy of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Chair on Myanmar, Ms. Heyzer; and Mr. Rajasingham.

“Statements were made by the representatives of the United Kingdom, Gabon, Ghana, Albania, Mexico, Kenya, China, France, the Russian Federation, the United Arab Emirates, India, Brazil, the United States, Ireland and the President of the Security Council, speaking in her capacity as the representative of Norway.

“His Excellency Mr. Pram Sokhonn, Ms. Heyzer, and Mr. Rajasingham responded to comments and questions raised.”
