Report of the Secretary-General on the situation in Abyei (S/2023/777)

Members of the Council have before them document S/2023/852, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the United States of America.

I should like to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2023/777, which contains

the report of the Secretary-General on the situation in Abyei.
