Resolution 1951 (2010)**Adopted by the Security Council at its 6431st meeting,
on 24 November 2010***The Security Council,**Recalling* its previous resolutions and statements of its President relating to the situation in Côte d'Ivoire and in the subregion,*Noting* the letter of 22 November 2010 from the Secretary-General concerning the planned run-off elections scheduled to take place in Côte d'Ivoire on 28 November 2010,*Recalling* the inter-mission cooperation arrangements provided for in paragraphs 4 to 6 of Security Council resolution 1609 (2005),*Also mindful* of the need to support UNMIL's ability to carry out its mandate,*Determining* that the situation in Côte d'Ivoire continues to pose a threat to international peace and security in the region,*Acting* under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

1. *Decides* to authorize the Secretary-General to temporarily redeploy from UNMIL to UNOCI for a period of no more than four weeks a maximum of three infantry companies and an aviation unit comprised of two military utility helicopters;

2. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
