## Resolution 2523 (2020)

### Adopted by the Security Council on 29 May 2020

*The Security Council,*

*Reaffirming* all its previous resolutions and presidential statements concerning the situation in Sudan and underlining the importance of full compliance with and implementation of these,

*Reaffirming* its strong commitment to the sovereignty, unity, independence and territorial integrity of Sudan,

*Determining* that the situation in Sudan constitutes a threat to international peace and security,

*Acting* under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

1. *Decides* that the African Union-United Nations Mission Hybrid Operation in Darfur (UNAMID) shall maintain its current troop and police ceilings until 3 June 2020, and *further decides* that during this period UNAMID shall maintain all team sites for mandate implementation;

2. *Expresses its intention* to decide by 3 June 2020, courses of action regarding the responsible drawdown and exit of UNAMID, and *further expresses* its intention to adopt a new resolution at the same time, establishing a follow-on presence to UNAMID;

3. *Decides* to remain seized of the matter.
