PROPOSALS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA FOR INCLUSION IN
THE FINAL DECLARATION

1. Proposals for the preamble:

Add the following as a new paragraph 2:

Recognizing the urgent need for the early adoption of specific practical measures aimed at the prevention of nuclear war;

Add as a new paragraph 4:

Emphasizing that the Treaty represents a contribution to the prevention of nuclear war;

Add the following as a new paragraph 5:

Noting the urgent need to prevent the expansion of the arms race to new environments explored by man;

2. Proposal for the section on purposes:

This section should start by the following:

The States parties to the Treaty reaffirm their commitment to continue negotiations the immediate objective of which is the elimination of the danger of the outbreak of nuclear war and the realization of measures that would stop and reverse the arms race and pave the way towards the lasting peace. They confirm that the final objective of these efforts is the achievement of the Treaty on general and complete disarmament under strict and effective international control.
