PROPOSAL OF THE DELEGATION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

Article VII

1. After an interval of not less than five years after the first Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Prohibition of the Emplacement of Nuclear Weapons and other Weapons of Mass Destruction on the Sea-Bed and the Ocean Floor and in the Subsoil thereof, a majority of the States Parties to this Convention may obtain, by submitting a proposal to this effect to the depositary governments, the convening of a conference with the same objectives.
 2. If no Review Conference has been convened pursuant to paragraph 1 of this Resolution within ten years following the conclusions of a previous Review Conference, the depositary governments shall solicit the views of all States Parties to this Convention on the holding of such a conference. If at least ten States Parties respond affirmatively, the depositary governments shall take immediate steps to convene the conference.
