List of candidates nominated by States parties for election to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to article 2, paragraph 1, of annex II to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf shall consist of 21 members who shall be experts in the field of geology, geophysics or hydrography, elected by States parties to the Convention from among their nationals, having due regard to the need to ensure equitable geographical representation, who shall serve in their personal capacities.
2. In a communication dated 30 November 2011, the Secretary-General invited States parties to submit nominations.
3. At the end of the nomination period, on 4 March 2012, the Secretary-General has received 24 nominations. Pursuant to article 2, paragraph 2, of annex II to the Convention, a list of all candidates thus nominated is set out, in alphabetical order, in the annex to this note.
4. The curricula vitae of the candidates will be circulated in document SPLOS/240.
5. The election will be held during the twenty-second Meeting of States Parties, to be held from 4 to 11 June 2012. The election procedure for consideration by the Meeting is set out in document SPLOS/238.
