Curriculum vitae of a candidate for election to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf nominated after the prescribed deadline

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Secretary-General addressed a communication dated 30 November 2011 to States parties inviting them to submit, between 5 December 2011 and 4 March 2012, the names of candidates whom their Governments might wish to nominate for the election of members of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, together with a statement of their qualifications. It was noted that the election would take place during the twenty-second Meeting of States Parties, to be held from 4 to 11 June 2012 in New York.
2. By a note verbale dated 29 May 2012, the Permanent Mission of Georgia to the United Nations informed the Secretary-General of the decision of the Government of Georgia to nominate Mr. George Jaoshvili for election to the Commission. A copy of Mr. Jaoshvili's curriculum vitae, as submitted by the Permanent Mission, is set out in the annex to the present note.
3. Given that the nomination by the Government of Georgia was received after the deadline, the issue of its receivability will be decided by the Meeting of States Parties during the discussion of agenda item 9, Election of 21 members of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf (see SPLOS/238, SPLOS/239 and SPLOS/240).
