**Election of twenty-one members of the Commission on the
Limits of the Continental Shelf**

List of candidates nominated by States parties for election to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to article 2, paragraph 1, of annex II to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf shall consist of 21 members who shall be experts in the field of geology, geophysics or hydrography, elected by States parties to the Convention from among their nationals, having due regard to the need to ensure equitable geographical representation, who shall serve in their personal capacities.
2. In a communication dated 15 December 2021, the Secretary-General invited States parties to submit nominations.
3. As at the end of the nomination period, on 15 March 2022, the Secretary-General had received 25 nominations. Pursuant to article 2, paragraph 2, of annex II to the Convention, a list of all candidates thus nominated, in alphabetical order by surname, is set out in the annex to the present note. The list also contains the nationalities and the nominating States of the candidates. Pursuant to the request made by the twenty-sixth Meeting of States Parties, the list also contains information on the undertaking by nominating States to support their candidates in accordance with article 2, paragraph 5, of annex II to the Convention (see [SPLOS/303](#), para. 79).
4. The statements of qualifications of the candidates will be circulated in document [SPLOS/32/10](#).
5. The election will be held at the thirty-second Meeting of States Parties, from 13 to 17 June 2022. The election procedure for consideration by the Meeting is set out in document [SPLOS/32/8](#).
