### Note by the Secretary-General

#### Addendum

1. The Secretary-General addressed a communication dated 15 December 2021 to States parties inviting them to submit, between 16 December 2021 and 15 March 2022, the names of candidates whom their Governments might wish to nominate for the election of members of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, together with a statement of their qualifications. It was noted that the election would take place during the thirty-second Meeting of States Parties, to be held from 13 to 17 June 2022 in New York.
2. By a note verbale dated 11 January 2022 and received by the Secretariat on 28 March 2022, the Permanent Mission of Oman to the United Nations informed the Secretary-General of the decision of the Government of Oman to nominate Adnan Rashid Nasser Al-Azri for election to the Commission for a term for the period 2023–2028.
3. The statement of qualifications and curriculum vitae of Mr. Al-Azri will be included in documents [SPLOS/32/10](#) and [SPLOS/32/CRP.1](#), respectively. The Government of Oman has confirmed its support for the candidate in accordance with article 2, paragraph 5, of annex II to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, pursuant to the request made by the twenty-sixth Meeting of States Parties (see [SPLOS/303](#), para. 79).
4. Given that the nomination by the Government of Oman was received after the deadline, the issue of its receivability will be decided by the Meeting of States Parties during the consideration of agenda item 13, election of 21 members of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf (see [SPLOS/32/8](#), [SPLOS/32/9](#) and [SPLOS/32/10](#)).<sup>1</sup>
