Addendum

1. Following the issuance of document SPLOS/INF/22, the Secretary-General received an additional submission made in accordance with the requirements of article 76 of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and with the Rules of Procedure¹ and the Scientific and Technical Guidelines² of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf.
2. On 1 June 2009, Cuba submitted to the Commission information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea is measured in the Eastern sector of the Gulf of Mexico.
3. In addition, following the issuance of document SPLOS/INF/22, Comoros transmitted, in accordance with paragraph 1 (a) of document SPLOS/183, preliminary information to the Secretary-General on 2 June 2009.
