Secretary-General's bulletin

Management Committee

The Secretary-General, for the purpose of amending the composition of the Management Committee, promulgates the following:

Section 2.1 of Secretary-General's bulletin [ST/SGB/2011/3](#) is replaced by the following text:

2.1 The Management Committee shall be chaired by the Chef de Cabinet, on behalf of the Secretary-General. Its members shall consist of the Under-Secretary-General for Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance, the Under-Secretary-General for Operational Support, the Under-Secretary-General for Safety and Security, the Under-Secretary-General for Humanitarian Affairs and Emergency Relief Coordinator, the Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs, the Under-Secretary-General for General Assembly and Conference Management, the Under-Secretary-General for Legal Affairs and United Nations Legal Counsel, the Under-Secretary-General for Global Communications, the Assistant Secretary-General for Human Resources, the Assistant Secretary-General for Programme Planning, Finance and Budget, Controller, the Chief Information Technology Officer, the Assistant Secretary-General for Support Operations, the Assistant Secretary-General for Development Coordination, the Assistant Secretary-General for Supply Chain Management, and on rotation one regional and shared Assistant Secretary-General from the Departments of Political and Peacebuilding Affairs and Peace Operations,¹ as well as the Coordinator of the regional commissions and the Directors-General of the United Nations Office at Geneva, the United Nations Office at Nairobi and the United Nations Office at Vienna.

¹ The three regional and shared Assistant Secretaries-General from the Departments of Political and Peacebuilding Affairs and Peace Operations that will attend the Management Committee on a rotating basis include: the Assistant Secretary-General for the Middle East, Asia and the Pacific, the Assistant Secretary-General for Africa and the Assistant Secretary-General for Europe, Central Asia and the Americas.



The present amendment supersedes Secretary-General's bulletin [ST/SGB/2011/3/Amend.1](#) of 16 November 2012 and shall enter into force on the date of its issuance.
