F. Visas and transportation

Visas

Participants who require a visa must contact the competent diplomatic or consular authorities of Belgium and apply for a Schengen short-stay (C) visa **at least three weeks prior to their intended date of arrival in Belgium**. In countries where Belgium does not have diplomatic or consular representation, visa applications can be submitted to the consular authority of a State party to the Schengen Agreement acting on behalf of Belgium in the country concerned. **Participants are expected to make their own visa arrangements.**

Transportation

1. Participants are responsible for making their own arrangements for transportation between the airport and Brussels city centre.
2. Arriving at the airport, participants can take a taxi to their hotel. There are also trains and buses to the city centre:
 - Taxi: Taxis with a taximeter are permanently available in front of the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the Brussels city centre is normally around 45 €.
 - Train: The airport train station is located below the terminal (level -1). Up to 6 trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels North, Brussels Central and Brussels South stations (about a 15 minute ride). Brussels Central and Brussels South are the stations that are situated closest to the hotels.
 - Bus: The bus station is located one floor down from the arrivals hall (level 0). The Airport Line is a 30-minute express service between Brussels Airport and the European quarter, situated not very far from the hotels. From Monday to Friday 8 p.m. the Airport Line is operated as an express service with number 12. On weekdays after 8 p.m., and the whole day on Saturday, Sunday and holidays the Airport Line is operated as a regular service with number 21.
