Lebanon*

Pursuant to paragraph 3 of resolution 52/38 B of 9 December 1997, and paragraph 5 (a) of resolution 52/38 R of 9 December 1997, both of which are entitled "Transparency in armaments", the States members of the League of Arab States reiterate their affirmation of the importance of transparency in armaments, both conventional weapons and weapons of mass destruction, and of the fundamental link between the two types of armaments. This was made clear during the fifty-second session of the General Assembly, in the previous reply of the Arab States on this subject, which appeared in document A/52/312.
