

Mexico

In a note verbale dated 29 April 2009, the Permanent Mission of Mexico to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that:

The Government of Mexico has offered to Western Sahara (Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic), a total of six scholarships, three of which are granted as part of the Non-Self-Governing Territories Programme, while the other three are granted as part of the Asia, Pacific, Africa and Middle East Programme (APAMO). Currently, there is a Saharan studying in Mexico who was given a scholarship for the period from August 2008 to July 2009, with the possibility of extension until July 2010, to study for a master's degree in education at the Autonomous University of Chapingo.
