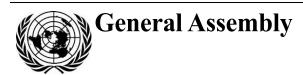

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

- 1. The previous recommendation made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 148 is set out in the report of the Committee contained in document A/72/669.
- 2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 32nd and 34th meetings, on 16 and 29 March 2018. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records.¹
- 3. For its further consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Report of the Secretary-General on the construction of a new facility for the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals, Arusha branch (A/72/734);
- (b) Related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/72/785).

II. Consideration of draft resolution A/C.5/72/L.25

- 4. At its 34th meeting, on 29 March, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled "Construction of a new facility for the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals, Arusha branch" (A/C.5/72/L.25), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Colombia.
- 5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.5/72/L.25 without a vote (see para. 6).
