Addendum

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Ji-sun Jun (Republic of Korea) from the Committee on Contributions, effective 28 February 2023. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Ms. Jun, which expires on 31 December 2023.
2. The Government of the Republic of Korea has nominated Minhong Yi to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Ms. Jun.
3. In a communication dated 17 March 2023, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Asia-Pacific States that the candidature of Mr. Yi had been endorsed by the group.
