Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2022, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. At its 11th meeting, on 4 November 2022, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
 - (a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2022 ([A/77/102](#));
 - (b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023 ([A/C.5/77/6/Rev.1](#)).
3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint or reappoint Cheikh Tidiane Dème (Senegal), Gordon Eckersley (Australia), Helena Concepción Felip Salazar (Paraguay), Bernardo Greiver del Hoyo (Uruguay), Marcel Jullier (Switzerland) and Joseph Masila (Kenya) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023 (see para. 4).
