

Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Marinko Avramović (Bosnia and Herzegovina)

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2022, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. At its 11th meeting, on 4 November 2022, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee that would occur as a result of the expiration of the terms of office of three of its members on 31 December 2022 (A/77/105);
- (b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023 (A/C.5/77/9).
- 3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint or reappoint Anton V. Kosyanenko (Russian Federation) and Suresh Raj Sharma (Nepal) as members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023 (see para. 4). The appointment for the remaining vacancy beginning on 1 January 2023 was postponed to a later date.





Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint the following persons as members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023:
