I

Survey mission handbook

Endorses the intention of the Secretariat to complete development of a survey mission handbook as described in paragraphs 8 and 9 of the report of the Secretary-General; 1/

II

Funding of public information activities

Endorses the proposal of the Secretary-General and requests the Committee on Information to review the policy of the Secretariat on the dissemination of information related to peace-keeping;

III

United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund

Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly the views of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board on the implications for the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund of the participation in the Fund of the different categories of civilian staff in peace-keeping operations;

IV

Provision of services to troops

Endorses the comments of the Secretary-General with regard to the provision, through local contractors, of services to troops;

V

Portable and temporary accommodation

Endorses the comments of the Secretary-General;

VI

Operational support manual

Endorses the intention of the Secretariat to complete development of an operational support manual.
