## 69/3. United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response and the Office of the Special Envoy on Ebola<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

- 1. Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General;<sup>1</sup>
- 2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;<sup>2</sup>
- 3. Recalls paragraph 24 of the report of the Advisory Committee, and emphasizes that the adoption of the present resolution is without prejudice to any subsequent review of the United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response by the General Assembly and any decision it may take with regard to the budgetary arrangements, organizational structure, staffing and operational requirements of the Mission, when it considers the detailed budget submission by the Secretary-General.
