

The decision of the Russian Federation to withdraw from the Eastern European Group of the Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production and Stockpiling of Bacteriological (Biological) and Toxin Weapons and on their Destruction (BTWC)

Submitted by the Russian Federation

- 1. One State for purely political reasons makes attempts to infringe on the rights of the Russian Federation in the framework of the Eastern European Group (EEG). We consider such actions as aimed to discriminate our country in the EEG, as an unfounded restriction of our inalienable right to be nominated and participate in the work of the BTWC bodies, including as a member of the bureau of the BTWC Ninth Review Conference. We see this as an attempt to downplay Russia's constructive contribution to the activities of the Convention.
- 2. Such dishonest attitude towards the Russian Federation undermines the credibility and effectiveness of the EEG and the BTWC as a whole. We do not exclude that by doing so they are trying to force us to take similar discriminatory measures and block the establishment of the bureau of the BTWC Ninth Review Conference and the work of the Conference as a whole.
- 3. However, we are avoiding any provocations. In order to ensure smooth work of the BTWC and taking into account the existing challenges (including financial issues) we did not ban any other nominations under the EEG. For us, unlike the above mentioned State Party, it is of vital importance to successfully hold the Ninth Review Conference, negotiate its consensus final document, ensure effective functioning of the Convention rather than satisfy self-serving politicized ambitions.
- 4. At the same time, we are aware that due to the current political situation and anti-Russia policy pursued by the above mentioned State Party at all international fora, we can hardly expect that the situation with the EEG would change in the near future. We will no way put up with this. However, we do not intend to obstruct the substantial work under the Convention.
- 5. In this regard, we inform you of the decision of the Russian Federation to withdraw from the BTWC EEG and to form a new regional group under this Convention, consisting of one country the Russian Federation. We would ask the States Parties as well as the BTWC Implementation Support Unit to take it into account in organizing further work under the Convention.
- 6. We would like to emphasize that our withdrawal from the BTWC EEG does not set a precedent, concerns only the work within the Convention and has no consequences with regard to the work of UN bodies or our membership in the EEG within the UN. We would ask that this decision, as well as the other understandings we have indicated in this regard, be reflected in the Final Document of the BTWC Ninth Review Conference.
