### Organization of work of the session

#### Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The draft organization of work of the fifty-fifth session of the Commission on Population and Development, which is contained in the annex to the present note, has been prepared in order to facilitate the Commission's consideration of the items included in the agenda of the session, given the time and conference services that have been allocated to it. The annotated provisional agenda of the session is contained in document E/CN.9/2022/1.
- 2. The modalities on the arrangements for the work of the Commission are specific to the fifty-fifth session and have been prepared taking into account the limitations and restrictions resulting from the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic. In-person meetings are to be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 to 6 p.m. In principle, virtual meetings with remote interpretation, which will be limited to two hours, are to be held during the working hours of in-person meetings.
- 3. Given the evolving situation in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic, there remains the need for a flexible approach that would allow the Bureau, in consultation with the membership of the Commission, to make adjustments during the session.
