Letter dated 15 May 2015 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to the exchange of letters dated 31 March and 2 April 2015 (S/2015/234 and S/2015/235) with the President of the Security Council pertaining to the expansion of the United Nations guard unit in Mogadishu.

I am pleased to inform you of the progress made in implementing the decision of the Security Council. Uganda has agreed to contribute, from newly generated troops, the additional 120 personnel required for the guard unit, bringing the total number of personnel deployed to 530. They are expected to begin their deployment during the course of the current month.
