Letter dated 11 March 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2562 \(2021\)](#), adopted on 11 February 2021, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on the Sudan until 12 March 2022.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1591 \(2005\)](#) concerning the Sudan, I have appointed the following experts as from 13 March 2021:

Ms. Priscilla Ciesay, international humanitarian law (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)

Mr. Nikolai Dobronravin, regional issues (Russian Federation)

Mr. Patrick Loots, arms and armed groups (South Africa)

Mr. Rajeev Yadav, finance (India)

In addition, I have appointed Mr. Vincent Darracq, transport and customs expert (France), to serve on the Panel of Experts until 22 October 2021, when he will reach the maximum period of service under the applicable rules and regulations of the United Nations.

I have designated Ms. Ciesay to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

I should be grateful if you would bring the present letter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
