COMMUNICATION DATED 25 NOVEMBER 1950 FROM THE CHINESE REPRESENTATIVE TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-CENERAL

New York, 25 November 1950

I have the honour to transmit the following telegraphic message from Mr. Ma Wen Yuen, Chairman of the General Assembly of all Chinese Associations, Schools and People of Pontianak, Indonesia, dated 20 November 1950.

The text of the message reads as follows:

"KINDLY SUBMIT FOR ATTENTION SECRETARY GENERAL UNO THE RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF ALL CHINESE ASSOCIATIONS SCHOOLS AND PEOPLE OF PONTIANAK INDONESIA IN CELEBRATING PRESIDENT CHIANG'S 64TH EIRTHDAY: (1) FULLY SUPPORT OUR NATIONAL GOVERNMENT (2) DISAGREE DISCUSSING ABOUT FORMOSA PROBLEMS (3) STRONGLY OPPOSED TO CHINESE COMMUNIST DELEGATION PARTICIPATING IN ANY UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE."

I request that my letter be issued as a General Assembly document and circulated to all delegations to the fifth regular session of the General Assembly.
