CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SEVENTH SESSION
OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Third report of the Credentials Committee^{1/}

Chairman: Mr. Karim AZKOUL (Lebanon)

1. The Credentials Committee, appointed by the General Assembly at its 376th plenary meeting on 14 October 1952, reconvened at Headquarters on 25 March 1953.
2. Representatives of the following Member States on the Committee participated in the meeting:

Belgium, Burma, Lebanon, Panama, Paraguay, Sweden, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United States of America.
3. The Committee examined the communications transmitted to the Secretary-General by the following Member States, which had appointed new representatives since the submission of the Committee's second report (A/2343):

Australia, Burma, Chile, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Israel, Liberia, Mexico, Norway, Philippines, Poland, Sweden, United States of America, Uruguay.
4. The Committee found that the Member States listed above had submitted credentials for their new representatives satisfying the requirements of rule 27 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.
5. The Committee further noted that, in accordance with rule 26 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the head of the Argentine delegation had appointed an alternate representative to act as representative.
