**Письмо Постоянного представителя Кипра при Организации
Объединенных Наций от 8 июня 2018 года на имя
Генерального секретаря**

По поручению правительства моей страны имею честь настоящим препроводить два документа со сведениями о совершенных Турцией нарушениях международных правил воздушного движения и вторжениях в национальное воздушное пространство Республики Кипр (см. приложение I), а также о незаконном использовании закрытых портов турецкими военными кораблями (см. приложение II) в марте 2018 года.

Я хотел бы также сообщить Вам о том, что оккупационный режим незаконно направил три извещения летным экипажам в связи с проведением учений турецких военно-воздушных сил в марте 2018 года.

Следует также отметить, что самолеты турецких коммерческих авиакомпаний систематически используют незаконный аэропорт Тимбу. Кроме того, Турция посредством радиообмена продолжает систематически создавать помехи для гражданской и военной авиации в районе полетной информации (РПИ) Никосии. При этом с прежней регулярностью продолжаются вторжения в РПИ Никосии и национальное воздушное пространство Республики Кипр. Проводимая Турцией политика постоянного нарушения норм международного права и пренебрежения международными правилами и положениями угрожает безопасности международной гражданской авиации, отрицательно сказывается на стабильности в регионе и создает трудности для пролета воздушных судов над Кипром.

Вышеупомянутые действия Турции, которая незаконно оккупирует северную часть Республики Кипр с 1974 года, явно рассчитаны на то, чтобы подрывать суверенитет Республики Кипр, привести к сохранению фактического разделения и повысить статус сепаратистского образования путем предъявления претензий на воздушное пространство над оккупированной территорией Республики. В этой связи я хотел бы вновь подчеркнуть, что на Кипре существует только одно законное государство — Республика Кипр, как это предусмотрено в



различных резолюциях Совета Безопасности, в частности резолюциях [541 \(1983\)](#) и [550 \(1984\)](#), в которых Совет объявил создание так называемой «Турецкой Республики Северного Кипра» не имеющим законной силы.

От имени правительства моей страны я заявляю решительный протест в связи с продолжающимися нарушениями Турцией международных правил воздушного движения и ее вторжениями в национальное воздушное пространство и территориальные воды Республики Кипр и призываю к их немедленному прекращению. В этой связи Республика Кипр вновь обращается с призывом соблюдать принцип суверенитета и невмешательства, закрепленный в Уставе Организации Объединенных Наций.

Наконец, я хотел бы настоятельно призвать Турцию и киприотов-турок прислушаться к призывам международного сообщества и содействовать конструктивному возобновлению мирного процесса, вместо того чтобы целенаправленно добиваться подрыва суверенитета Республики Кипр, закрепления сохраняющегося фактического разделения и повышения статуса сепаратистского образования.

Буду признателен Вам за распространение настоящего письма и приложений к нему в качестве документа Генеральной Ассамблеи по пункту 44 повестки дня и документа Совета Безопасности.
