**Письмо Постоянного представителя Кипра при Организации  
Объединенных Наций от 27 мая 2021 года на имя  
Генерального секретаря**

По поручению правительства моей страны настоящим препровождаю четыре отдельных документа, содержащих сведения о совершенных Турцией вторжениях в национальное воздушное пространство Кипра, нарушениях международных правил воздушного движения в районе полетной информации Кипра, а также незаконном использовании ею закрытых портов и аэропортов на Кипре в феврале и марте 2021 года (см. приложения I–IV)\*.

Международная гражданская авиация по-прежнему сталкивается с ситуацией, когда одно из государств — членов Международной организации гражданской авиации (ИКАО), а именно Турция, не соблюдает основополагающие положения Конвенции о международной гражданской авиации и приложения к ней, что создает потенциальные риски для международной воздушной навигации. Турция посредством радиообмена продолжает систематически создавать помехи для гражданской и военной авиации в районе полетной информации Никосии, в то время как сепаратистский режим, установленный Турцией в части Кипра, находящейся под ее незаконной военной оккупацией, якобы направляет извещения для авиационного персонала в связи с учениями, которые проводят турецкие военно-воздушные силы.

Указанные действия Турции явно рассчитаны на подрыв суверенитета Кипра, закрепление сохраняющегося фактического раздела острова и повышение статуса сепаратистского режима на основании предполагаемого существования отдельного воздушного пространства над оккупированной территорией Республики. В этой связи следует отметить, что существует только одно кипрское государство — Республика Кипр, что закреплено, среди прочего, в различных резолюциях Совета Безопасности, в частности в резолюциях [541 \(1983\)](#) и [550 \(1984\)](#). Соответственно, для ИКАО Республика Кипр является единственным признанным на международном уровне государством, ответственным за обслуживание воздушного движения в пределах всего района полетной информации Никосии, а также за предоставление аэронавигационной информации,

касающейся этого района полетной информации. Аэропорты, расположенные в оккупированной части Кипра, так называемая «диспетчерская служба аэропорта “Эрджан”» или «служба полетных рекомендаций в системе управления воздушным движением аэропорта “Эрджан”» и подразделения «управления воздушным движением» (не перечисленные в региональном плане аэронавигации) являются незаконными, и, следовательно, их деятельность является недействительной и не учитывается на оперативном уровне в международной воздушной навигации и сообществом гражданской авиации.

В единоличном порядке и в нарушение международного права, подтверждаемого, в частности, в соответствующих резолюциях Совета Безопасности, Турция настаивает на своих незаконных претензиях, пытаясь навязать свое мнение и называя это «существующим положением дел на местах». С точки зрения Турции, так называемое «положение дел на местах» по существу является ситуацией, которую она создала на Кипре в результате применения силы в нарушение статьи 2 Устава Организации Объединенных Наций и военной оккупации одной трети территории Республики Кипр и связанных с этим нарушений прав человека.

К сожалению, вследствие такого понимания Турцией «реальности» неофициальная встреча по Кипру в формате «пять плюс один» (Женева, 27–29 апреля 2021 года) завершилась безрезультатно. Выдвинув в качестве предварительного условия возобновления официальных переговоров «признание двух государств на Кипре», что является вопиющим нарушением положений соответствующих резолюций Совета Безопасности и явным игнорированием принятых Организацией Объединенных Наций параметров и имеющихся наработок, Турция при поддержке лидера киприотов-турок не позволила участвующим сторонам выработать четкий план наиболее эффективного выхода из тупика на основе официальных переговоров.

В равной степени вызывает обеспокоенность то, что Турция проигнорировала Ваш призыв ко всем сторонам в Женеве воздерживаться от любых односторонних действий, которые могут вызвать напряженность, и недавно приступила к назначению так называемого «консула» в оккупированном городе Фамагуста. В этой связи следует напомнить, что в резолюции 550 (1984) Совет Безопасности, заявив, что он «серьезно озабочен дальнейшими сепаратистскими акциями на оккупированной части Республики Кипр, которые являются нарушением резолюции 541 (1983), а именно так называемым обменом послами между Турцией и юридически незаконной «Турецкой Республикой Северного Кипра», а также другими действиями или угрозами действий, направленными на дальнейшее укрепление так называемого независимого государства и раздела Кипра», осудил эти действия, объявил их незаконными и не имеющими силы и призвал к отказу от них. Вместо выполнения этих резолюций Турция продолжает умышленно пренебрегать международным правом, ускоряя осуществление своих незаконных программ и действия в огороженном районе Вароша и подрывая стабильность в Восточном Средиземноморье своим агрессивным поведением и риторикой. Так, обращаясь к молодым людям в Турции по случаю празднования 19 мая Дня молодежи и спорта, президент Турции Реджеп Тайип Эрдоган заявил, что «Турция не ограничена 780 000 квадратных километров, а присутствует везде» и по этой причине действует в Палестине, на Кипре, в Восточном Средиземноморье и Ираке. Президент также упомянул незаконные буровые работы его страны в этом районе, подтвердил вызывающую обеспокоенность информацию о том, что в оккупированной части Кипра находится турецкая база беспилотных летательных аппаратов, и повторил, что он посетит ее 20 июля по случаю годовщины вторжения Турции в 1974 году в целях «направления всему миру необходимых сообщений».

Несмотря на все препятствия, мы по-прежнему привержены предусмотренному варианту создания двухзональной и двухобщинной федерации на основе политического равенства в соответствии с многочисленными резолюциями Совета Безопасности. В этой связи нас обнадеживает Ваше заявление в ходе пресс-конференции, состоявшейся в Женеве по окончании неофициальной встречи в формате «пять плюс один», о сохранении приверженности и поддержке усилий по возобновлению официальных переговоров.

Буду признателен Вам за распространение настоящего письма и приложений к нему в качестве документа Генеральной Ассамблеи по пункту 44 повестки дня и документа Совета Безопасности.
