Carta de fecha 27 de mayo de 2021 dirigida al Secretario General por el Representante Permanente de Chipre ante las Naciones Unidas

Siguiendo instrucciones de mi Gobierno, adjunto a la presente carta cuatro documentos en los que se detallan las violaciones del espacio aéreo nacional de Chipre y las infracciones de las normas internacionales de tráfico aéreo en la región de información de vuelo de Chipre cometidas por Turquía y los casos de uso ilegal por Turquía de puertos y aeropuertos clausurados de Chipre durante los meses de febrero y marzo de 2021 (véanse anexos I a IV)*.

La aviación civil internacional sigue enfrentándose a una situación en la que uno de los Estados miembros de la Organización de la Aviación Civil Internacional (OACI), a saber, Turquía, no respeta las disposiciones fundamentales del Convenio sobre Aviación Civil Internacional y sus anexos, lo que conlleva posibles riesgos para la navegación aérea internacional. Turquía sigue acosando sistemáticamente a las aeronaves civiles y militares dentro de la región de información de vuelo de Nicosia con llamadas de radio, mientras que el régimen secesionista que ha instalado en la zona de Chipre al amparo de la ocupación militar ilegal de Turquía pretende emitir avisos a los aviadores en relación con maniobras realizadas por la Fuerza Aérea de Turquía.

Estas acciones de Turquía obedecen al claro propósito de socavar la soberanía de Chipre, afianzar la actual división *de facto* de la isla y tratar de elevar el estatus del régimen secesionista mediante la supuesta existencia de un espacio aéreo separado sobre el territorio ocupado de la República. A ese respecto, conviene señalar que, tal como se estipula, entre otras, en diversas resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad, en particular las resoluciones [541 \(1983\)](#) y [550 \(1984\)](#), solamente existe un Estado chipriota, que es la República de Chipre y, por consiguiente, para la OACI la República de Chipre es el único Estado reconocido internacionalmente con competencias para prestar servicios de tránsito aéreo en la totalidad de la región de información de vuelo de Nicosia y para publicar información aeronáutica relativa a esa región de información de vuelo. Los aeropuertos ubicados en la zona ocupada de Chipre, así como la creación del llamado “espacio aéreo con servicio de

asesoramiento de Ercan” o “servicios de aviso de tráfico aéreo de Ercan” y de unidades de “control del tráfico aéreo” (que no figuran en el plan regional de navegación aérea) son ilegales y, por consiguiente, su actividad es nula y carente de validez y no es tomada en cuenta a nivel operativo por la navegación aérea internacional ni por la comunidad de la aviación civil.

En total soledad, y en contravención del derecho internacional establecido por, entre otras cosas, las resoluciones pertinentes del Consejo de Seguridad, Turquía insiste en sus reivindicaciones ilícitas intentando imponer sus puntos de vista de lo que llama “las realidades actuales sobre el terreno”. Según Turquía, las supuestas “realidades sobre el terreno” son de hecho la situación que creó en Chipre mediante el uso de la fuerza, en violación del Artículo 2 de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas, y la ocupación militar de un tercio del territorio de la República de Chipre y las consiguientes violaciones de los derechos humanos.

Lamentablemente, la percepción turca de la “realidad” provocó que la reunión oficiosa de los cinco más uno sobre Chipre (Ginebra, 27 a 29 de abril de 2021) quedara inconclusa. Al establecer como condición previa para la reanudación de las conversaciones oficiales el “reconocimiento de dos Estados en Chipre”, en flagrante contravención de lo dispuesto en las resoluciones pertinentes del Consejo de Seguridad y haciendo caso omiso de los parámetros establecidos por las Naciones Unidas y de labor realizada hasta la fecha, Turquía, en consonancia con el líder turcochipriota, hizo imposible que los participantes encontraran un camino para salir del punto muerto a través de negociaciones oficiales.

Es igualmente preocupante que Turquía haya hecho caso omiso del llamamiento que usted dirigió a todas las partes en Ginebra para que se abstuvieran de cualquier acto unilateral que pudiera aumentar la tensión y haya procedido recientemente a nombrar un supuesto “cónsul” en la ciudad ocupada de Famagusta. A este respecto, cabe recordar que en la resolución [550 \(1984\)](#) el Consejo de Seguridad, tras declararse gravemente preocupado por los nuevos actos secesionistas en la parte ocupada de la República de Chipre, que constituían una violación de la resolución [541 \(1983\)](#), a saber, el pretendido intercambio de embajadores entre Turquía y la “República Turca de Chipre Septentrional”, la cual carecía de validez jurídica, así como por otras medidas o amenazas de medidas encaminadas a seguir consolidando el supuesto Estado independiente y la división de Chipre, condenó dichas medidas, las declaró ilícitas e inválidas y pidió su abrogación. En lugar de acatar esas resoluciones, Turquía sigue haciendo caso omiso del derecho internacional al acelerar la realización de planes y la adopción de medidas ilícitas en la zona vallada de Varosha y socavar la estabilidad en el Mediterráneo oriental a causa de la agresividad de su comportamiento y discurso. De hecho, al dirigirse a los jóvenes turcos con motivo del Día de la Juventud y el Deporte, celebrado el 19 de mayo, el Presidente de Turquía, Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, afirmó que “Turquía no se limita a 780.000 kilómetros cuadrados, está en todas partes” y que por ello estaba adoptando medidas en Palestina, Chipre, el Mediterráneo oriental y el Iraq. El Presidente también se refirió a las actividades ilegales de perforación de su país en la zona, confirmó la preocupante información de que una base de drones turcos operaba en la parte ocupada de Chipre y reiteró que visitaría esta última el 20 de julio, con motivo del aniversario de la invasión turca de 1974, para “enviar los mensajes necesarios a todo el mundo”.

A pesar de todos los obstáculos, seguimos comprometidos con la forma de solución prevista de una federación bizonal y bicomunal, con igualdad política, tal como se define en numerosas resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad. A este respecto, nos alienta su declaración de persistencia y determinación con respecto a los esfuerzos para reanudar las negociaciones formales durante la conferencia de prensa celebrada al final de la reunión oficiosa de los cinco más uno en Ginebra.

Le agradecería que tuviera a bien hacer distribuir la presente carta y sus anexos como documento de la Asamblea General, en relación con el tema 44 del programa, y del Consejo de Seguridad.
