2021 年 8 月 6 日塞浦路斯常驻联合国代表给秘书长的信

奉我国政府指示，谨随函转递四份单独的文件，其中记录了土耳其在 2021 年 4 月和 5 月期间侵犯塞浦路斯国家领空、在飞行情报区违反国际空中交通管制条例以及非法使用塞浦路斯非开放港口和机场的行为(见附件一至四)。^{*}

国际民用航空继续面临作为国际民用航空组织(国际民航组织)成员国之一的土耳其不遵守《国际民用航空公约》及其附件的基本规定、从而给国际空中航行带来潜在风险的局面。土耳其继续通过无线电呼叫有系统地骚扰尼科西亚飞行情报区内的民用和军用飞机。此外，土耳其指示它在其非法军事占领的塞浦路斯地区所建立的分离主义政权发布(据称已发布)6 份关于土耳其空军演习的所谓“飞行员通知”。

土耳其的上述行动显然旨在破坏塞浦路斯的主权，巩固该岛持续存在的事实上分裂的局面，并试图通过声称在塞浦路斯被占领土上存在不同领空来提升分离主义政权的地位。在这方面，应当指出，正如安全理事会各项决议、特别是第 541(1983)和 550(1984)号决议所规定，世界上只有一个塞浦路斯国家，即塞浦路斯共和国，因此，对于国际民航组织而言，塞浦路斯共和国是唯一得到国际承认的负责在整个尼科西亚飞行情报区提供空中交通服务和发布有关该飞行情报区航空情报的国家。位于塞浦路斯被占区的机场以及设立所谓的“埃坎咨询空域”或“埃坎空中交通咨询服务”和“空中交通管制”单位(未列入区域空中导航计划)的行为都是非法的，因此它们的活动是无效的，在业务上不被国际空航和民航界考虑。

安全理事会相关决议所反映的土耳其的侵略行为和对国际法的持续蔑视在 2021 年 7 月达到新的高度，进一步危及瓦罗沙合法居民已遭侵犯的人权，并严重损害解决塞浦路斯问题的前景。

具体而言，土耳其总统公然无视安全理事会主席 2020 年 10 月 9 日关于瓦罗沙的明确声明(S/PRST/2020/9)以及欧洲联盟等国际行为体的相关警告，并于 2021 年 7 月 20 日与土族塞人领导人一道宣布“瓦罗沙开放的第二阶段”。

2021 年 7 月 23 日，土耳其对以规则为基础的国际秩序的蔑视变本加厉，土耳其外交部发布一份新闻稿(第 260 号)，对安全理事会使用不敬语言。安全理事会在履行《宪章》赋予的职责时，于同天通过一项主席声明(S/PRST/2021/13)，谴责土耳其关于瓦罗沙的上述公告。外交部则若无其事表示拒绝接受这一声明，并促请“国际社会面对岛上的现实”。7 月 29 日，外交部就安全理事会关于延长联合国驻塞浦路斯维持和平部队任务期限的第 2587(2021)号决议发布了一份类似具有挑衅性的新闻稿(第 265 号)，除其他外，促请“安全理事会和国际社会集中精力在现实基础上达成解决方案”。

土耳其对“现实”的这种看法导致关于塞浦路斯问题的“五加一”非正式会议(2021 年 4 月 27 日至 29 日)无果而终，而土耳其的看法依然冥顽不化。土耳其总统在 2021 年 7 月 20 日非法访问塞浦路斯被占区期间，再次要求“承认塞浦路斯的两个国家”，这公然违背了安全理事会相关决议的规定、联合国确立的标准和现有大量工作。

显然据土耳其所称，所谓的“当地目前的现实”就是土耳其通过违反《联合国宪章》第二条使用武力、对塞浦路斯共和国三分之一领土实行军事占领而在塞浦路斯一手造成的局面。土耳其不仅要求国际社会根据已经失效的征服权利理论承认侵略导致的变化，而且公开宣称它将继续违反安全理事会决议，完全无视《宪章》第二十五条。

安全理事会必须捍卫其各项决议，确保这些决议有意义；否则，我们就有可能破坏国际体系的信誉。

尽管存在种种障碍，我们仍然致力于在两区两族联邦的基础上达成解决方案，致力于按照安全理事会各项决议的规定，实现政治平等。在这方面，正如你在提交安理会的最新报告中展示的那样，你所表达的对努力恢复正式谈判的坚持和坚定决心令我们感到鼓舞。
