## Carta de fecha 6 de agosto de 2021 dirigida al Secretario General por el Representante Permanente de Chipre ante las Naciones Unidas

Siguiendo instrucciones de mi Gobierno, adjunto a la presente carta cuatro documentos en los que se detallan los casos en que Turquía ha violado el espacio aéreo nacional de Chipre, infringido las normas internacionales de tráfico aéreo en la región de información de vuelo y hecho un uso ilegal de los puertos y aeropuertos clausurados de Chipre durante los meses de abril y mayo de 2021 (véanse anexos I a IV)\*.

La aviación civil internacional sigue enfrentándose a una situación en la que uno de los Estados miembros de la Organización de la Aviación Civil Internacional (OACI), a saber, Turquía, no respeta las disposiciones fundamentales del Convenio sobre Aviación Civil Internacional y sus anexos, lo que conlleva posibles riesgos para la navegación aérea internacional. Turquía sigue acosando sistemáticamente a las aeronaves civiles y militares dentro de la región de información de vuelo de Nicosia con llamadas de radio. Además, dio instrucciones al régimen secesionista que ha instalado en la zona de Chipre al amparo de la ocupación militar ilegal de Turquía para que supuestamente emitiera seis de los llamados “avisos a los aviadores” en relación con maniobras realizadas por la Fuerza Aérea de Turquía.

Estas acciones de Turquía obedecen al claro propósito de socavar la soberanía de Chipre, afianzar la actual división *de facto* de la isla y tratar de elevar el estatus del régimen secesionista mediante la supuesta existencia de un espacio aéreo separado sobre el territorio ocupado de Chipre. A ese respecto, conviene señalar que, tal como se estipula, entre otras, en diversas resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad, en particular las resoluciones [541 \(1983\)](#) y [550 \(1984\)](#), solamente existe un Estado chipriota, que es la República de Chipre y, por consiguiente, para la OACI la República de Chipre es el único Estado reconocido internacionalmente con competencias para prestar servicios de tránsito aéreo en la totalidad de la región de información de vuelo de Nicosia y para publicar información aeronáutica relativa a esa región de información de vuelo. Los aeropuertos ubicados en la zona ocupada de Chipre, así como la creación del llamado “espacio aéreo con servicio de asesoramiento de Ercan” o “servicios de aviso de tráfico aéreo de Ercan” y de unidades de “control del tráfico aéreo” (que no figuran en el plan regional de navegación aérea) son ilegales y, por consiguiente, su actividad es nula y carente de

validez y no es tenida en cuenta a nivel operativo por la navegación aérea internacional ni por la comunidad de la aviación civil.

La conducta agresiva de Turquía y su continuo desdén por el derecho internacional, enunciado en las resoluciones pertinentes del Consejo de Seguridad, alcanzaron nuevas cotas en julio de 2021, lo que puso aún más en peligro los derechos humanos, que ya se habían violado, de los legítimos habitantes de Varosha y perjudicó gravemente las perspectivas de solución del problema de Chipre.

En concreto, el Presidente de Turquía ignoró descaradamente la inequívoca declaración de la Presidencia del Consejo de Seguridad sobre Varosha, de fecha 9 de octubre de 2020 ([S/PRST/2020/9](#)), así como las respectivas advertencias de los agentes internacionales, incluida la Unión Europea, y, el 20 de julio de 2021, junto con el dirigente turcochipriota, procedió a anunciar “la segunda fase de la apertura de Varosha”.

El desdén de Turquía por el orden internacional basado en normas quedó demostrado una vez más el 23 de julio de 2021, cuando el Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores turco emitió un comunicado de prensa (núm. 260) en el que utilizaba un lenguaje irrespetuoso hacia el Consejo de Seguridad, que, en cumplimiento de las funciones que le encomienda la Carta, adoptó, en la misma fecha, una declaración de su Presidencia ([S/PRST/2021/13](#)) en la que condenaba los mencionados anuncios que Turquía había hecho sobre Varosha. El Ministerio de Asuntos Exteriores afirma sin rodeos que rechaza la declaración y pide “a la comunidad internacional que afronte la realidad de la isla”. El 29 de julio, emitió un comunicado de prensa igualmente provocador (núm. 265) sobre la resolución [2587 \(2021\)](#) del Consejo de Seguridad relativa a la prórroga del mandato de la Fuerza de las Naciones Unidas para el Mantenimiento de la Paz en Chipre, en el que pedía, entre otras cosas, que el Consejo de Seguridad y la comunidad internacional se centraran en encontrar una solución basada en las realidades.

Turquía sigue aferrándose a su percepción de la “realidad”, que hizo que la reunión oficiosa de los cinco más uno sobre Chipre (27 a 29 de abril de 2021) no llegara a un resultado concluyente. Durante la visita ilegal que realizó a la zona ocupada de Chipre el 20 de julio de 2021, el Presidente turco volvió a pedir el “reconocimiento de la existencia de dos Estados en Chipre”, en flagrante contravención de lo dispuesto en las resoluciones pertinentes del Consejo de Seguridad, los parámetros establecidos por las Naciones Unidas y la labor realizada hasta la fecha.

Es obvio que las llamadas “realidades sobre el terreno” a las que se refiere Turquía son, de hecho, la situación que creó en Chipre mediante el uso de la fuerza, en violación del Artículo 2 de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas, y la ocupación militar de un tercio del territorio de la República de Chipre. Turquía exige que la comunidad internacional reconozca los cambios producidos por la agresión, en consonancia con la doctrina obsoleta del derecho de conquista, y declara abiertamente que seguirá violando las resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad, haciendo caso omiso del artículo 25 de la Carta.

El Consejo de Seguridad debe respaldar sus resoluciones y asegurarse de que tengan un significado; de lo contrario, se corre el riesgo de socavar la credibilidad del sistema internacional.

A pesar de todos los obstáculos, seguimos comprometidos con la solución basada en una federación bizonal y bicomunal con igualdad política, como se define en numerosas resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad. A este respecto, nos alienta su mensaje de persistencia y determinación con respecto a los esfuerzos por reanudar las negociaciones oficiales, expresado en sus últimos informes al Consejo.

Le agradecería que tuviera a bien hacer distribuir la presente carta y sus anexos como documento de la Asamblea General, en relación con el tema 44 del programa, y del Consejo de Seguridad.
