Information furnished in conformity with General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI) by States launching objects into orbit or beyond

Note verbale dated 6 July 2017 from the Permanent Mission of the Lao People's Democratic Republic to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of the Lao People's Democratic Republic to the United Nations (Vienna) has the honour to transmit, in accordance with paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI) of 20 December 1961, information on the launch of the communications satellite LaoSat-1, the first space object of the Lao People's Democratic Republic.

The LaoSat-1 communications satellite was successfully launched on 20 November 2015 into a 128.5 degree East orbital slot and is working normally up to the present.¹
