Note verbale dated 22 September 2021 from the Permanent Mission of Malaysia to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Malaysia to the United Nations (Vienna) has the honour to transmit, in accordance with paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI) of 20 December 1961, information concerning the registration of the MEASAT-3b satellite, which was launched by MEASAT Global Berhad of Malaysia on 11 September 2014 from Kourou, French Guiana (see annex).¹ The satellite remains in operation until further notice.
