- a. Country Study on Climate Change A US-AID assisted country project composed of the following study elements:
  - 1. Green House Gas Inventory
  - 2. Climate Change Scenario
  - 3. Vulnerability Assessment and Adaptation on:
    - accelerated sea level rise
    - \* water resources
    - \* agriculture
  - 4. Identification and Assessment of Mitigation Strategies
  - 5. Information and Education Campaign
  - 6. Development of National Action Plan
- b. Country Study on Biodiversity the study will identify and develop scientific information on the changing patterns of biodiversity in the areas affected by the expansion of drought affected areas.
- c. Establishment of Resource Information Management System, a computerassisted integrated database that will serve as benchmark information for the future requirements of monitoring changes in patten of agricultural utilization and agricultural productivity.
- d. Country Study on Sustainable Development This study will provide a review of the existing indigenous and adaptive agricultural and forestry technologies in the various agro-climate regions in the Philippines. Seminars/workshops are now being held.
