 - (i) Statement: Accused No. 2 had made arrangements with HAJI BENGALI to

carry the drug to the ship, but said that another fat Bengali gave him the drug that morning. Accused No. 2 in turn engaged Accused No. 1 to carry part of the opium. Accused No. 1 was first arrested and gave a description of Accused No. 2, who he said was also carrying opium. A watch was accordingly maintained and resulted in the arrest of Accused No. 1. Accused No. 2 was to receive Rs.210/- (U.S. \$63.30) for the 'trip', out of which he said he could pay Accused No. 1, Rs.10/- (U.S. \$3.00).
