Information furnished in conformity with the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space

Note verbale dated 18 November 2013 from the Permanent Mission of Argentina to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Argentina to the United Nations (Vienna), in accordance with article IV of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space (General Assembly resolution 3235 (XXIX), annex), has the honour to transmit additional information concerning Argentine space object SAC-C, previously registered with the Secretary-General of the United Nations in document ST/SRG/SER.E/382.

According to the National Commission on Space Activities, on 15 August 2013, at 0605 hours UTC, it was not possible to make contact with the SAC-C satellite. Following four further unsuccessful attempts to establish contact, the operations of SAC-C have been declared ceased as of the aforementioned date.
