Note verbale dated 4 October 2021 from the Permanent Mission of Spain to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Spain to the United Nations (Vienna), in accordance with article IV of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space (General Assembly resolution 3235 (XXIX), annex), has the honour to submit additional information on space object UPM Sat-2, a satellite that was registered in 2020 and erroneously entered as UMPSat-2 instead of UPM Sat-2 (see annex). All other parameters remain unchanged. Spain has corrected its entry in the Spanish National Registry. ¹
