Your communication T/PET.4/170 of 5/1/59

I have, on behalf of the Banso Branch of the ONE KAMERUN, to acknowledge the receipt of your communication mentioned above, advising us that our communication of 4th November 1958, has been circulated to the members of the Trusteeship Council for examination as a petition.

May I take this opportunity of extending the profound gratitude of this Office to you for the treatment you have given our mentioned communication, while I attach here-with three other petitions, urging that these be given keen attention by the Trusteeship Council, since the circumstances involved feature complete violation of Articles 8 and 13 of the Trusteeship Agreement for the Territory of the Cameroons under British Administration approved by the General Assembly on 13th December 1946, and are likely to cause an explosion in our home Town.
