PETITION FROM MR. DAVID WONHARCHE CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

To the Secretary-General of the United Nations

I wish to inform you hereby that we are undergoing mass repressions here. Arrests are multiplying. We are suffering very much under the colonialist yoke. Here they speak to us of the election of 28 December, which will take place under the Deffère-Olvida loi-cadre, which all the Kamerunian people reject. Moreover, we boycotted the municipal elections - the boycott was 90 per cent effective. The French have dissolved the UPC out of jealousy and because that very trustworthy movement (the UPC) discovered all the colonialist plans to incorporate Kamerun in the French Union (13 July 1955). But France cannot dissolve the UPC; on the contrary, we can dissolve the French Union in Kamerun.

WE REGUSE TO ACCEPT THE LOX-CADRE AND DOMESTIC AUTONOMY.

LONG LIVE UNIFICATION AND LONG LIVE THE UPC. IMMEDIATE INDEPENDENCE.
