ENLARGED SESSION LEADING COMMITTEE UNIKEMERUN AFTER HAVING DISCUSSED SITUATION  
CREATED TOGOLAND BY FRENCH GOVT GOING AGAINST FREELY EXPRESSED ASPIRATION  
POPULATIONS CONCERNED DISAPPROVES FACT THAT UNATIONS HAS FAVOURED SUCH SWINDLE  
CONTRARY DISPOSITIONS CHARTER BY NOT CARRYING REFERENDUM BOTH PARTS TOGOLAND  
SIMULTANEOUSLY STOP SINCE 1955 EASTERN KAMERUN POPULATIONS LIVE INSECURITY  
MATERIALIZED BY ABSOLUTE ARBITRARY DESPITE ALL INTERVENTIONS NEAR UNATIONS ON AND
